


PubMed searches:


Personalising your search

ARIIA PubMed searches are designed to retrieve aged care content on a particular topic. You can focus that topic further to an area of your own interest by following these steps.

1. Each ARIIA PubMed search will take you to the PubMed results page. Once here, click your cursor at the end of the search string in the main search box.




2. Enter your term or phrase (note: if you use a phrase, use "quotation marks"). Leave a space between the last bracket, then add AND with a space, then add your term or phrase. Then click search.



3. To add additional synonymous terms or phrases, repeat step 2 and use OR after each added term. Enclose these terms combined with OR in brackets as shown in image below.



4. You can change the order of how your results display by clicking on 'Display options'. PubMed automatically arranges them by relevance or 'best match.' You can also display them by the most recently published citations first.
